## **Wedding Timeline**

Time

#### **Description of event**

Guests arrive prelude song(s) will be played.
Wedding ceremony
Processional, Bridal entrance, interlude, & recessional song(s)
will be played during ceremony
Cocktail hour music is played. Wedding party photo session.
DJ introduction. The guests are asked to take their seats for the introduction of the wedding party.
Introduction of the wedding party with their introduction song(s) playing.
Introduction of the bride and groom with their introduction song playing.
Bride and Groom's first dance is announced. First dance song will be played. Then take seats for dinner.
The dinner toast, blessing, or prayer is announced. The DJ explains eating arrangements.
Dinner begins with background dinner music.
Toast given by the Best man, Maid of honor, and parent(s) will be
announced. With open mic if requested.
Bride and Groom give thanks.
Cake cutting will be announced



#### Time

#### **Description of event**

Father/Daughter dance
Mother/ Son dance (If parents are not big dancers you can relieve pressure from them by combining)
Anniversary Dance. DJ invites married couples to join the Bride & Groom on the dance floor. DJ will ask married couples to leave the dance floor according to years of marriage until the oldest married couple is on the dance floor.
Bride and Groom open the dance floor with Guests
Bouquet toss
Garter removal and toss
Money Dance
More dancing
Last Dance song announced.
